- d. BPA Rate Changes for Monthly Billing Cycle:
 - i. Discussion: Due to the transition in meters, this quarter billings will be billed at the base charge for all meters, with the exception of the school and any organizations that has bathrooms or water usage due to multiple members. Examples would be our churches or businesses. Those will be looked at for their average usage and decided if the base pertains to them. BPA will be looking at rate changes for monthly billings but will follow guidelines already in place.
- e. Other:
 - Discussion: Ms. Bradford asked about the Easement payment and what the committee would like to do. It will be discussed at council.
 - ii. Discussion: We are receiving out gas invoices from the school and Ms. Bradford needs to be able to reconcile them. The Auditor of State suggests gas logs with gallon usage and mileage for all Village vehicles. She will look to see if there has been anything in place prior and get it in place.
